You can be an inventor, too!

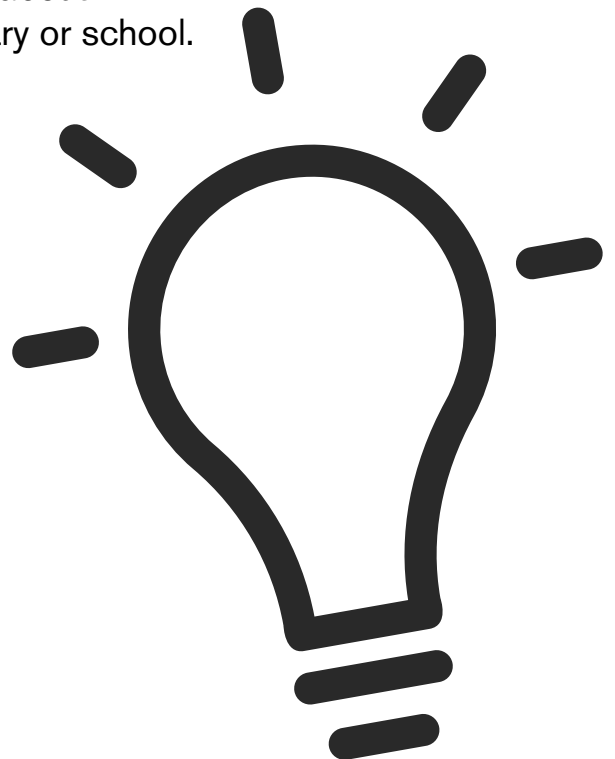
Get inspired by an inventor or invention that you learn about

Top inventors will win a special invention kit.



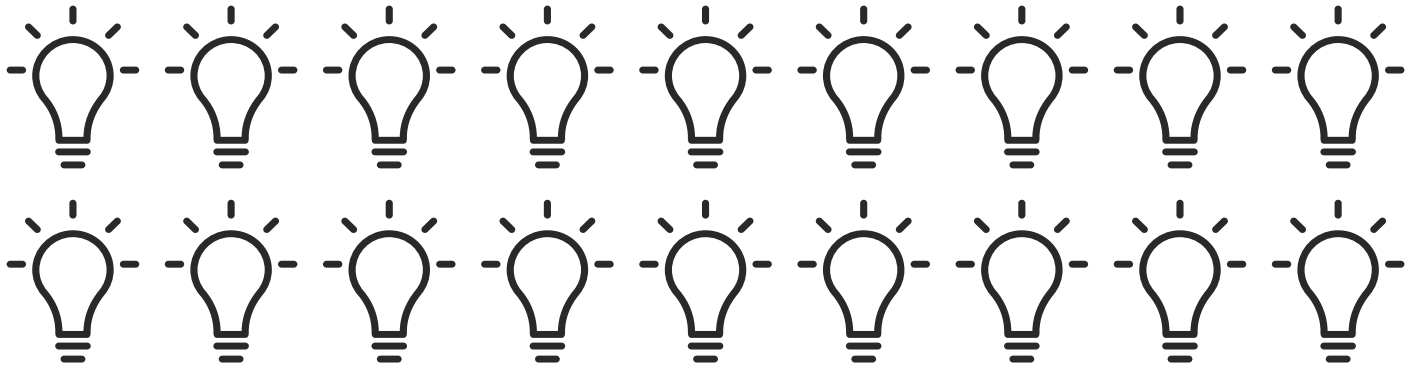
