GET A LIBRARY CARD

Chicago Residents

An adult must complete and sign a library card application.

- Chicago Public Library requires one piece of valid identification with photo, current name and address or a combination of two pieces of identification, one with name and address and one with name and photo.
- Accepted forms of ID include:
 - Any Illinois state-issued identification with name, address and photo
 - $\cdot\,$ A piece of mail with your Chicago address that matches the name on your photo ID.

High school students

Patrons 14 and older may show a current, valid student ID with name and photo and one piece of identification with the student's current address.

A child 13 or younger must present a completed and signed application that includes the signature of a parent or guarantor. One piece of identification with the child's current address must be presented.

Reciprocal Borrowers

Illinois residents who are reciprocal library users must present a current, valid library card from their local reciprocal library and one piece of ID with name and address. After verification from the home library, CPL will issue a Chicago Public Library card.

Rights and responsibilities are not transferrable. Unauthorized use of another person's library card number is expressly forbidden and will be subject to prosecution.

Replace Your Library Card

- If your library card, key fob or CityKey ID is lost, please report it to any CPL location immediately.
- You are responsible for all materials borrowed and any outstanding balance charged against your library card until its loss is reported to CPL.
- If your library card is lost, fill out a new application and present current, valid ID to get a new card. Upon presentation of a worn or damaged library card, we will replace the card at no cost.

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
